MEMORANDUM TO THE ACTING DEPUTY EXECUTIVE OFFICER,
OPERATIONS COORDINATING BOARD

FROM: PSB Interdepartmental Committee on the Implementation of
PSB D-21 (Germany) and D-21/2 (Berlin)

Pursuant to agreement reached among Departmental and Agency points-of-contact* at a meeting on October 7, 1953, with respect to the disposition of the subject documents, it is recommended that:

1. the principle of a "country plan" for operations affecting all of Germany, including Berlin, be maintained;
2. the existing papers (D-21 and D-21/2) be reviewed and revised in the light of:
 - a. approved applicable policies: NSC 132/1, 158, and 160/1;
 - b. approved PSB documents: PSB D-45
 - c. forthcoming PSB/OCB documents covering Western Europe and the Soviet Orbit; and
 - d. recent developments in Germany: uprisings in the Soviet Zone, elections in the Federal Republic, etc.

... as terms of reference.
3. the Board and its member Departments and Agencies (including USIA) designate appropriate representatives to execute the recommendations approved by the Board.
