"study and collect information concerning legal developments constituting a denial of equal protection of the laws under the Constitution,"

and its further duty to

"appraise the laws and policies of the Federal Government with respect to equal protection,"

the Commission also has held -

A Hearing on Housing
in New York City, New York
on February 2 and 3, 1959.

And in the same connection it has scheduled -

A Conference on Education
at Nashville, Tennessee
on March 5 and 6, 1959.
