

MISCELLANEOUS SERIES

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Miscellaneous Series contains approximately 2,740 pages and spans the period 1953-1961. The series consists of correspondence, memoranda, reports, briefing papers, press summaries, and transcripts of congressional testimony.

This material arrived at the Library in disarray. Although shipped to the Library along with the remainder of Dwight D. Eisenhower's Papers as President, it, unlike most of the President's papers, was not organized into a coherent series. A staff archivist arranged this Miscellaneous Series alphabetically by subject instead of interfiling the materials into other established series in the President's Papers. This was done for a number of reasons. Most of these materials either clearly do not belong in any other series or their relationships with documents in other series are tenuous. Many reports and transcripts of testimony located here are bulkier than documents filed in other series. Also, some documents in this series are duplicates of items found in other series or in other collections. In some cases, documentation such as that found in file folders entitled "Defense Reorganization" appears to be similar to that normally filed in the White House Staff Secretary's Records but was retained, possibly inadvertently, in the Ann Whitman File.

Topics documented in this series included government reorganization and Defense Department reorganization; the Panama Meeting of Presidents in July, 1956; highlights of United States foreign policy during the period 1953-61; and summaries of press coverage of the President's Far East trip in June 1960 and the U-2 incident. Also found in this series are reports by the President's Committee on International Information Activities (Jackson Committee) in 1953 and the Quantico Vulnerabilities Panel in 1955.

Approximately 450 pages were withdrawn because of security classification and 84 pages were closed in accordance with the donor's letter of gift. Eighteen photographs were transferred to the Library's audiovisual archives.
