SUBJECT: Youth Escapee Program



1. The meeting has been set for 10:00 A. M. tomorrow (Friday, March 13) here at PSB.

2. John Anspacher will be the PSB representative. I will keep in closest touch with him, and Art Cox will give him special help on the financial and administrative side.

3. The other representatives are:

- Pillsbury, of CIA
- Auslander, of State
- Wiggins, of ODMS, and
- Barringer, of Defense.

(Barringer may appoint one of his assistants instead of coming himself.)

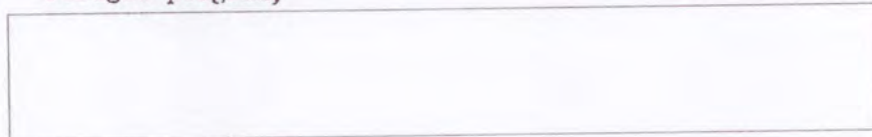

4. Pillsbury told Anspacher that CIA does not go along with this policy. He indicated that this is top-level CIA policy and that Allen Dulles, briefed by Bolton, is likely to mention this at the lunch today.

5. CIA's objections are:

a. That the defection of 100,000 East German youth would not have any really significant impact;

b. That the defection would create a "privileged" class in Western Germany and complicate the present refugee program;
