Dog Tags are metal identification tags used by the United States Armed Forces from World War I to the present day. Since World War I the Army has used elongated rectangular metal tags with rounded corners. All tags were embossed with the soldier's name, religion, and since World War II, the blood type and date of specific inoculations.
