


# EISENHOWER PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY, MUSEUM, and BOYHOOD HOME

## GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS

- Students visiting as an organized school group are admitted free of charge. Free admission is offered to one adult chaperone per every five students. We rely on the chaperones to make sure the group stays together.
- Upon arrival, please check in at the Gift Shop located in the Visitors Center building.
- Food and drinks, including gum and candy, are **not** allowed in any of the buildings.
- When visiting the Boyhood Home, we request your whole group visit at one time. A guide will tell the history of the Eisenhower Home and family from the front porch. Your group will then tour the inside and ask any questions they might have.

## GUIDELINES TO SHARE WITH YOUR GROUP IN ADVANCE

- Chaperones are asked to assist students in modeling appropriate museum etiquette and be respectful of the exhibits and other visitors.
- Chaperones are requested to keep a close eye and monitor student behavior as well as making sure the group stays together at all times.
- Food and drinks, including gum and candy, are **not** permitted in the buildings.
- Please speak in low voices in the buildings.
- No running in the buildings.
- Flash photography is not allowed in any of the buildings. Bring only cameras which do not have a flash or cameras which can have the flash turned off.
- With the exception of those unable to use stairs, students will not use the elevators or wheelchair lifts.
- **Do not touch or write** on paintings, exhibits, walls or glass cases.
